The territorial jurisdiction for the cases which are considered by the courts in the ATO zone has been defined

On 2 September 2014, the Highest Administrative Court of Ukraine and the Highest Commercial Court of Ukraine determined* that administrative and commercial disputes which are currently being considered by the courts within the ATO zone shall be transferred :

- from the Commercial Court of the **Donetsk** Region and the Donetsk District Administrative Court to the respective courts in **Zaporizhzhya**;
- from the Commercial Court of the **Luhansk** Region and the Luhansk District Administrative Court to the respective courts in **Kharkiv**;
- from the Donetsk Commercial Court of Appeals and Donetsk Administrative Court of Appeals to the respective appeal courts in Kharkiv.

The above mentioned cases should be transferred to the respective courts within 10 business days, i.e. by 15 September 2014.
