PROTECT AGAINST DATA SECURITY THREATS: STRATEGIES AND TECHNIQUES

The consequences to a breach in security can severely damage the reputation and performance of even the strongest organizations as well as leave governments with heavy losses. Cybercriminals are increasingly targeting governments, seeking to steal essential strategic information. An IDC's research shows that Asia-Pacific governments raise widespread concerns over illegal access to national confidential information (57%), attack against critical infrastructure (56%), purloined trade secrets and competitive information. This research also points out that data center is the most important part but also the most vulnerable one. (According to IDC, less than 5% of the \$27 billion spent on security products directly addressed data center security). In Vietnam, there few agencies, ministries, departments have a well-equipped security division, which easily lead to losses of data/ information in the era where

every organization could engage in economic espionage. Session 1 is specifically designed to give Information Professionals tools and measures to limit the threat of internal and external breaches in security while reducing the complexity and cost associated with securing information.

CYBER THREATS AND SOLUTIONS TO CREATE A SECURE ENVIRONMENT

Cyber threats will continue to multiply at a more pervasive, persistent and sophisticated level. Attackers have access to significant funding; they are more patient and sophisticated than ever before; and they are looking for vulnerabilities in the whole operating environment, including people and process. There is a clear and present danger, but organizations are not moving fast enough to mitigate the known vulnerabilities. As 2014 drew to a close, the hack against Sony dominated all cyber security conversations. The hacker group took over the corporate network, stole a treasure trove of sensitive data and dumped them online to expose plenty of private information such as email exchanges of executives, names and passwords, and personal information of involved parties. The recent attack reminds IT administrators to learn from such incidents and think ahead in terms of securing their network infrastructure. Given these challenges, this session will cover initiatives and solutions in addressing cyber risks to help organizations defend their own networks.
