Basic salary to increase from July 2023

At a glance...

The government has issued Decree 24/2023/ND-CP dated 14 May 2023 on new basic salary, which will come into effect from 1 July 2023, replacing Decree 38/2019/ND-CP.



In detail...

New basic salary effective from 1 July 2023

Under the recently issued Decree 24/2023/ND-CP, the basic salary will increase from VND1,490,000/month to VND1,800,000/month, with effect from 1 July 2023.

Capped salary for Social Insurance (SI) and Health Insurance (HI) contributions increases

Decree 24 governs only the pay rate for state officials, state employees and armed forces' personnel. However, as the contributions/payments of compulsory SI and HI of all employees, including non-state ones, are capped at 20 times basic salary, the capped amount will increase from VND29,800,000 to VND36,000,000.
