Update on electronic identification and authentication (eID) for foreigners

July 2025



At a glance

As a follow-up to our previous NewsBrief on corporate eID applicable to foreign legal representatives, a number of provincial Immigration Departments (eg. Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh City, Dong Nai) have now started registration procedures for Level-2 eID for foreigners, from 1 July, as the first step for corporate eID application.

Key steps include:

01

In-person visit by the foreign legal representative to the provincial Immigration Department.

02

The eID application form (Form TK01 under Decree No. 69/2024/NĐ-CP) must be completed and signed by the foreign legal representative.

03

Foreign applicant must also:

- hold a valid passport;
- hold a temporary residence card;
- have a Vietnam phone number registered under the applicant's name; and
- have an email address.

Foreigners who are not currently residing in Vietnam or do not hold a temporary residence card are not eligible to register for a Level-2 eID at this time and will need to wait for further guidance from the authorities.

We continue monitoring developments of the process and will keep you informed.
